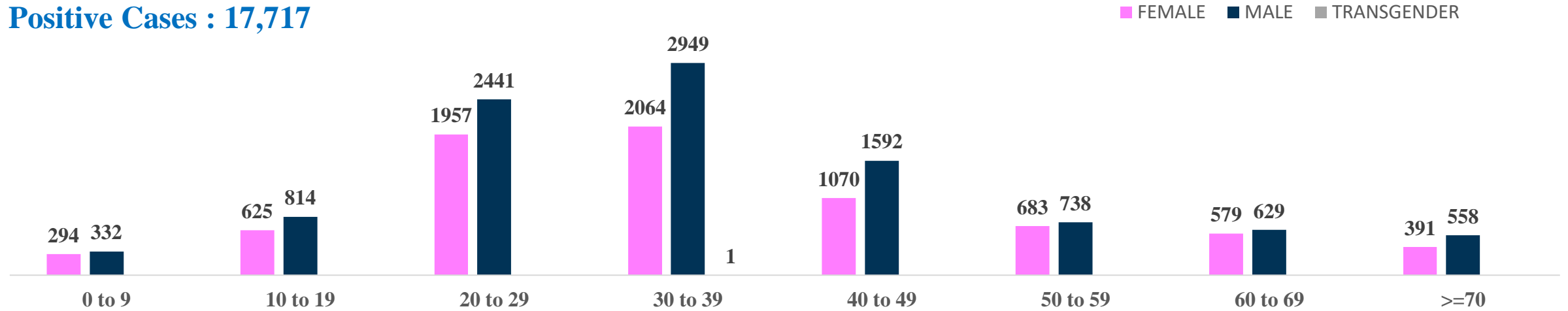

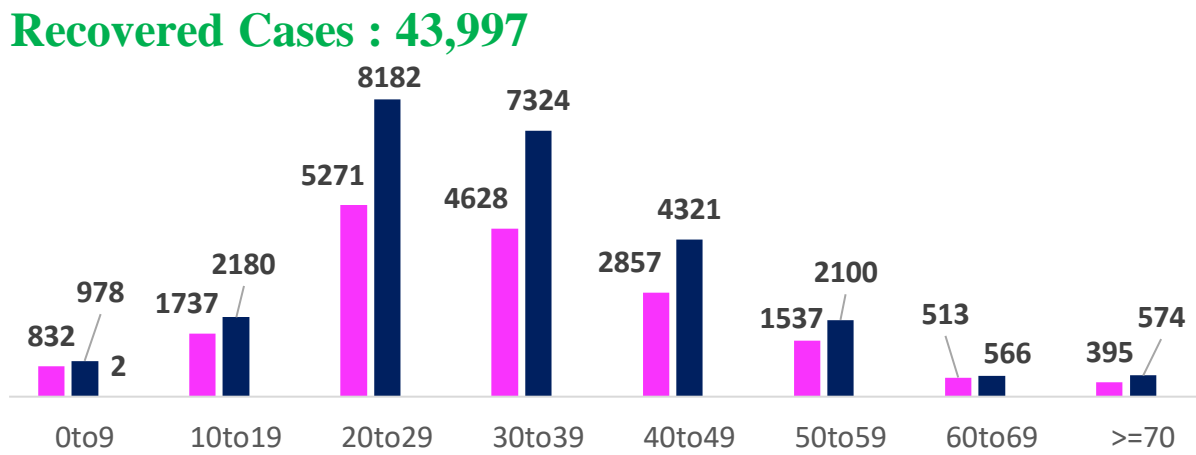
LAST 24 HOURS AGE GROUP AND GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION



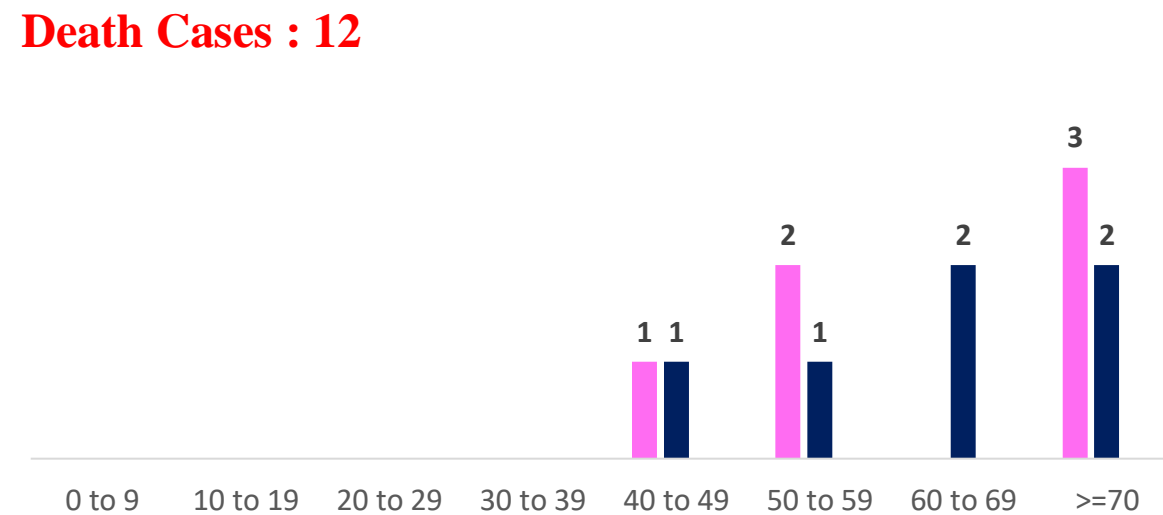

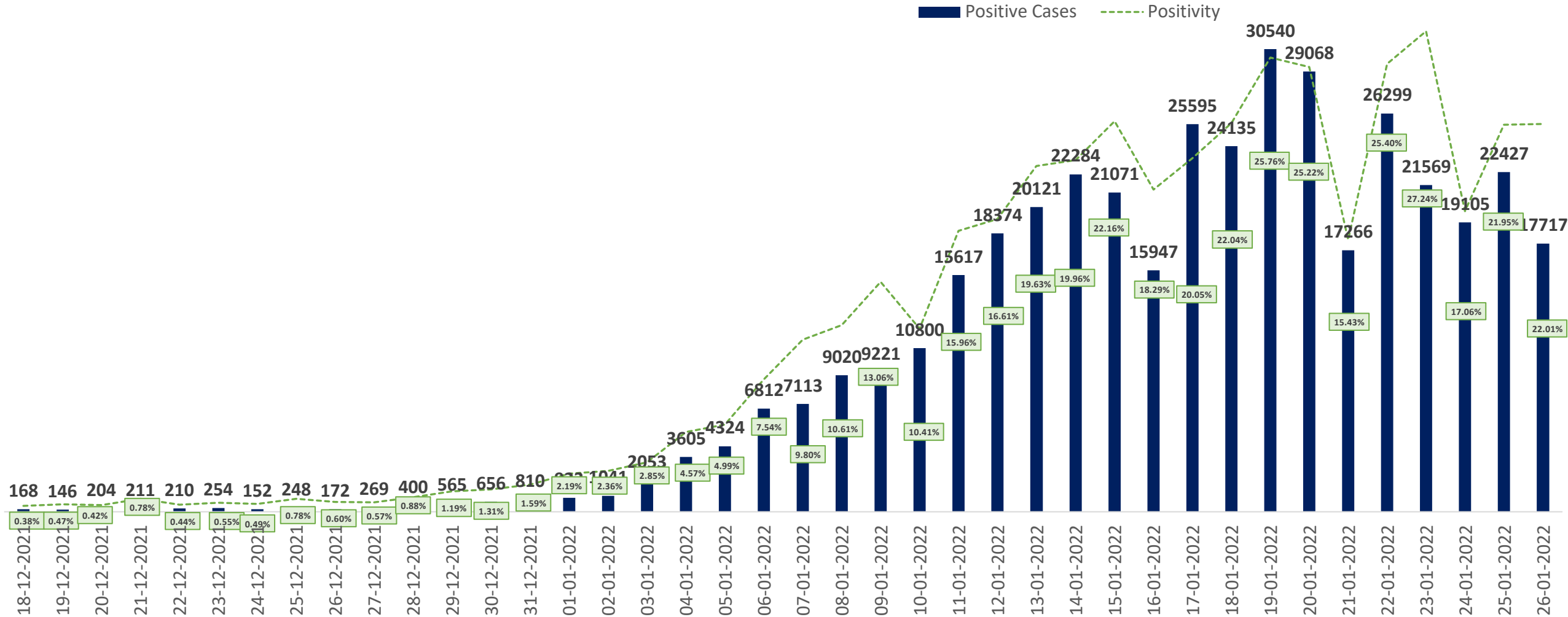

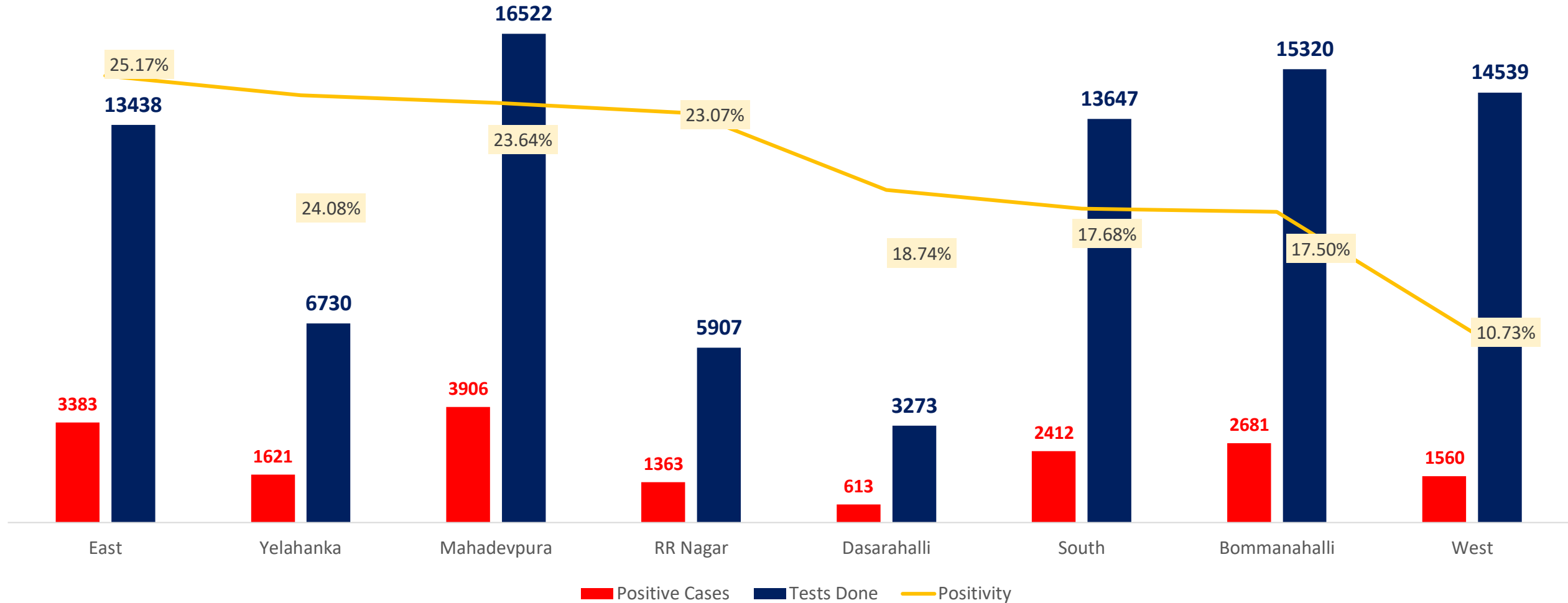


POSITIVITY RATE OF BENGALURU – LAST 40 DAYS



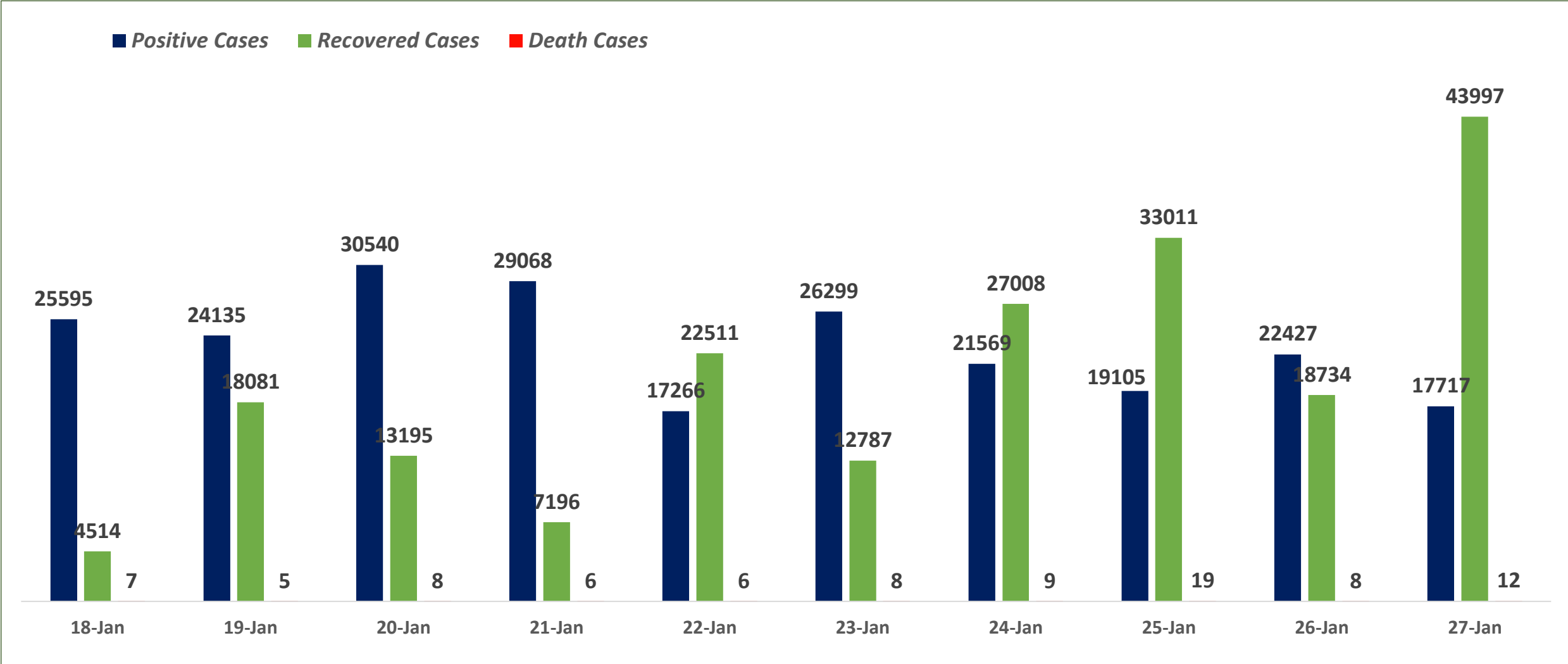


ZONE WISE AVERAGE POSITIVITY TREND FOR LAST 7 DAYS





SNAPSHOT OF POSITIVE, RECOVERED AND DEATH CASES OVER LAST 10 DAYS ACROSS BBMP ZONES

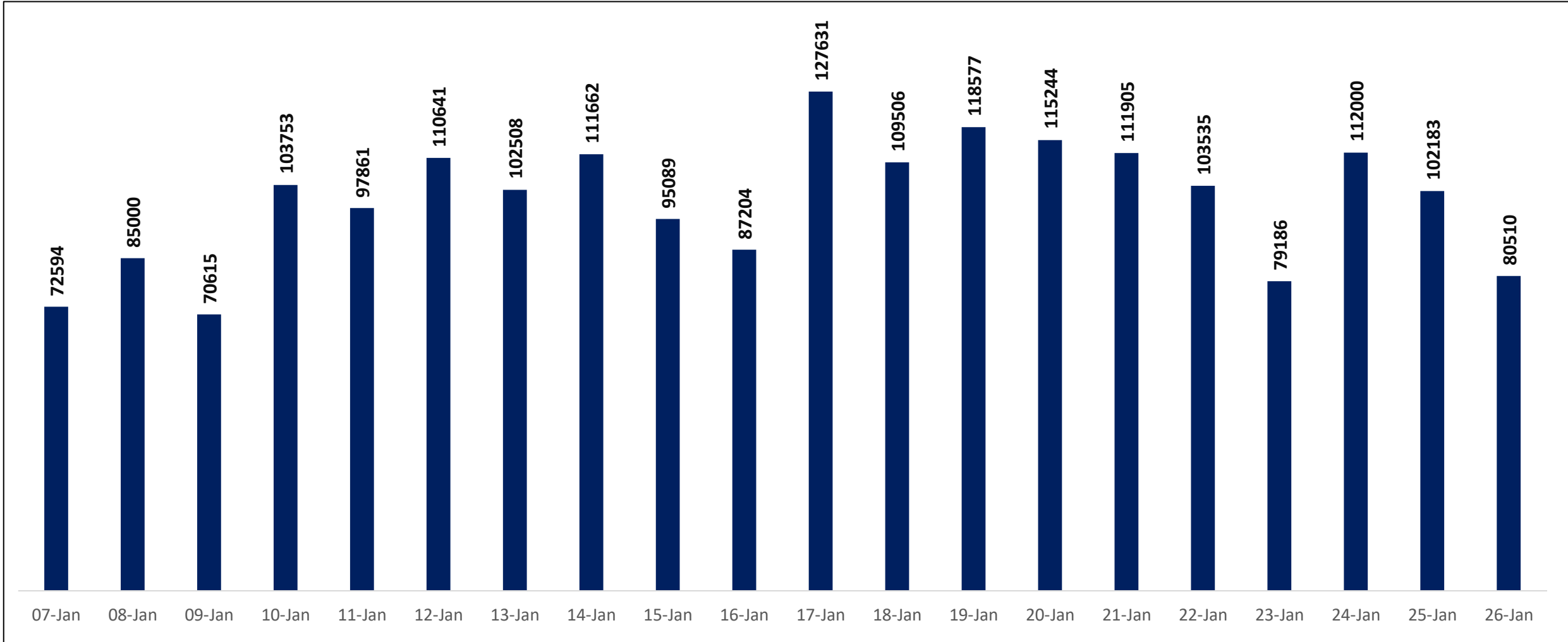

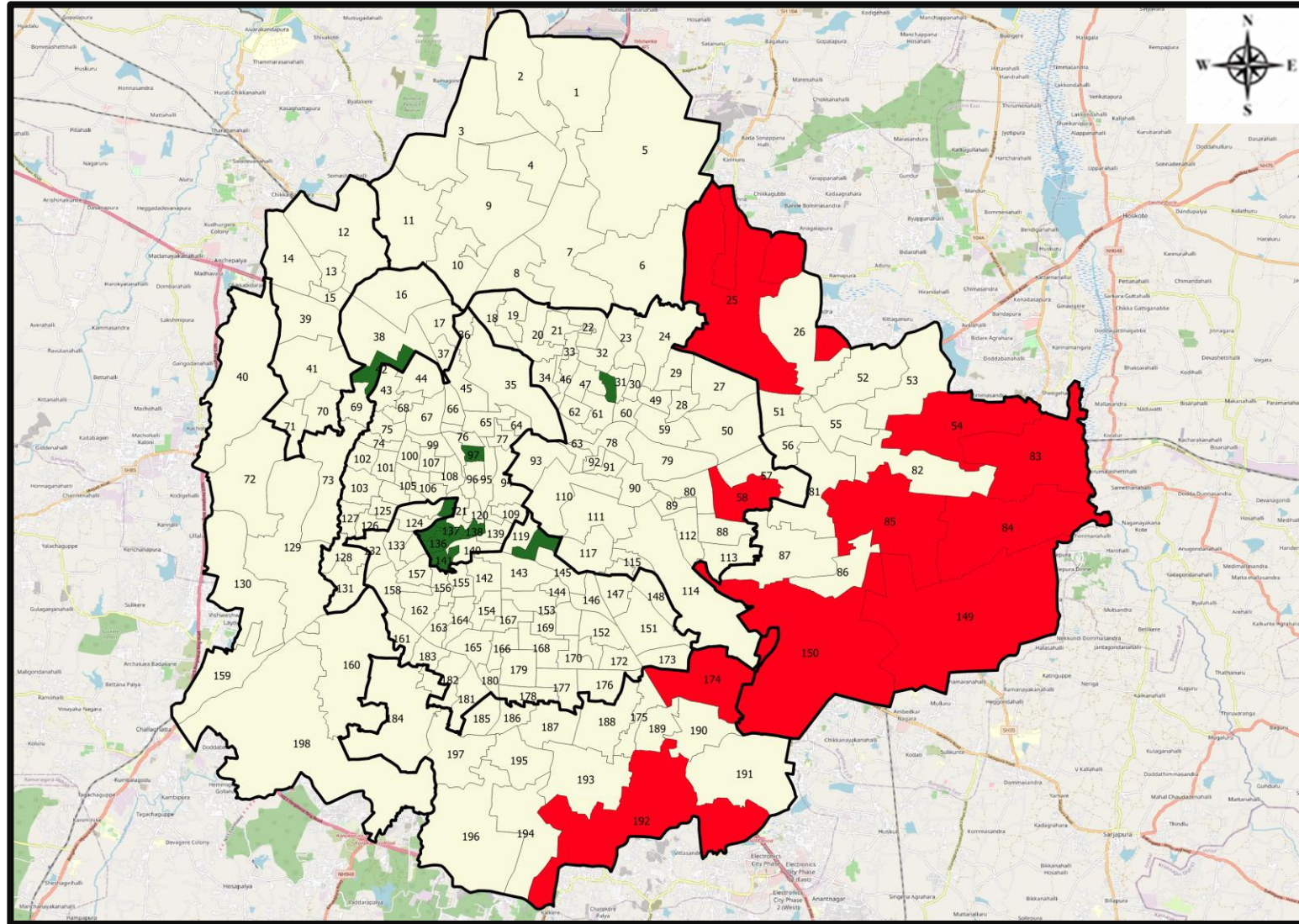

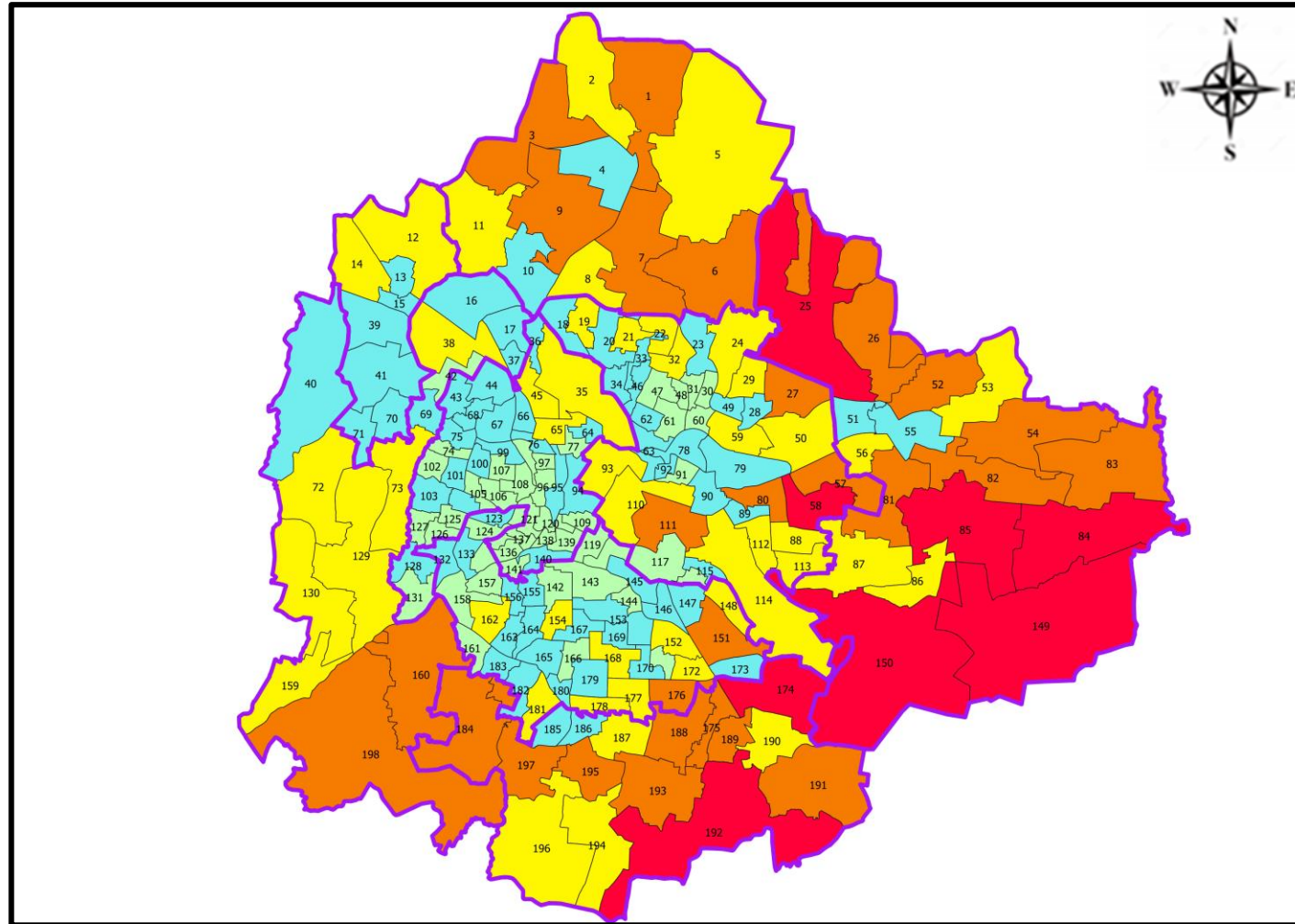

BENGALURU MAP SHOWING INTENSITY OF POSITIVE CASES IN LAST 7 DAYS



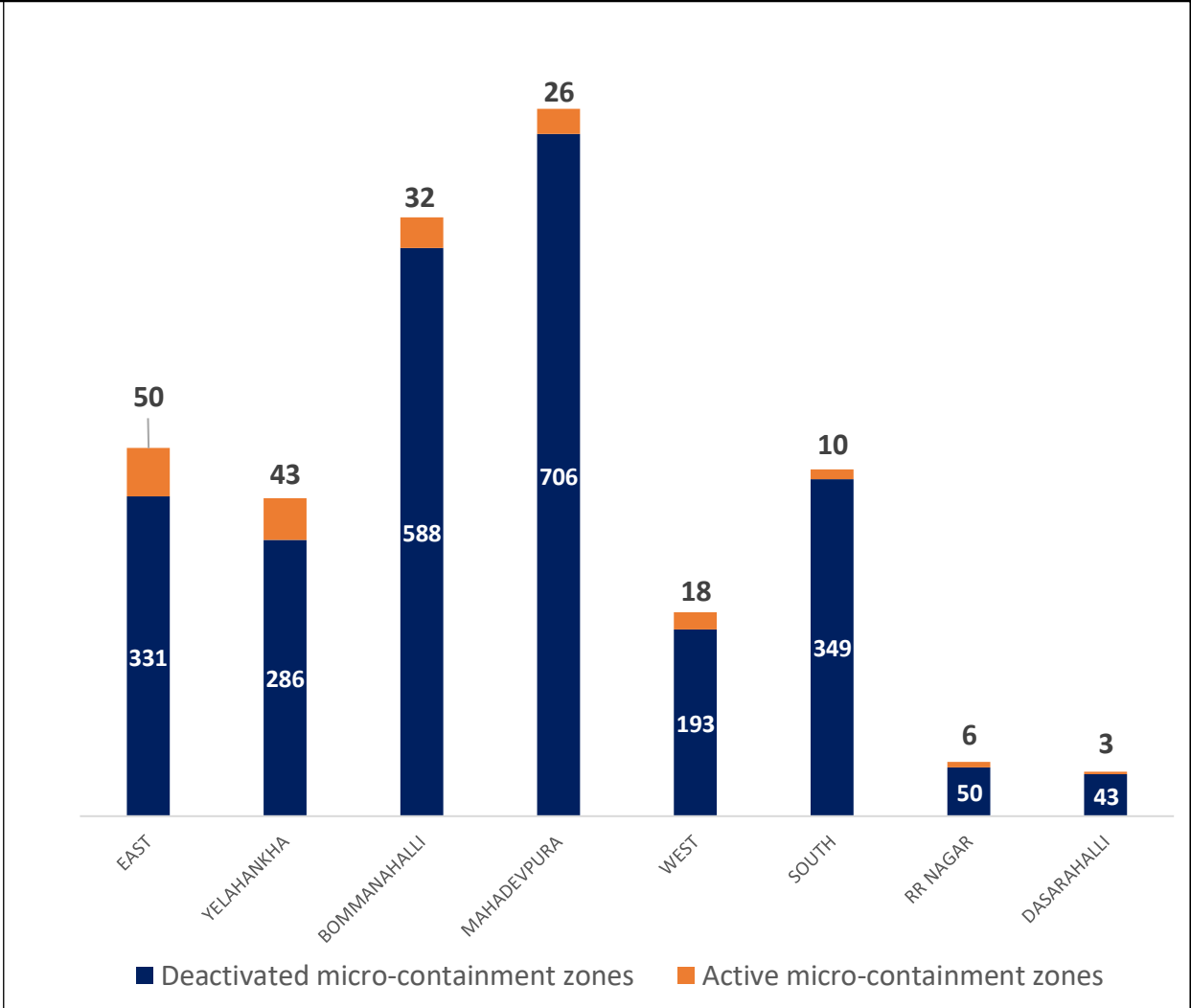

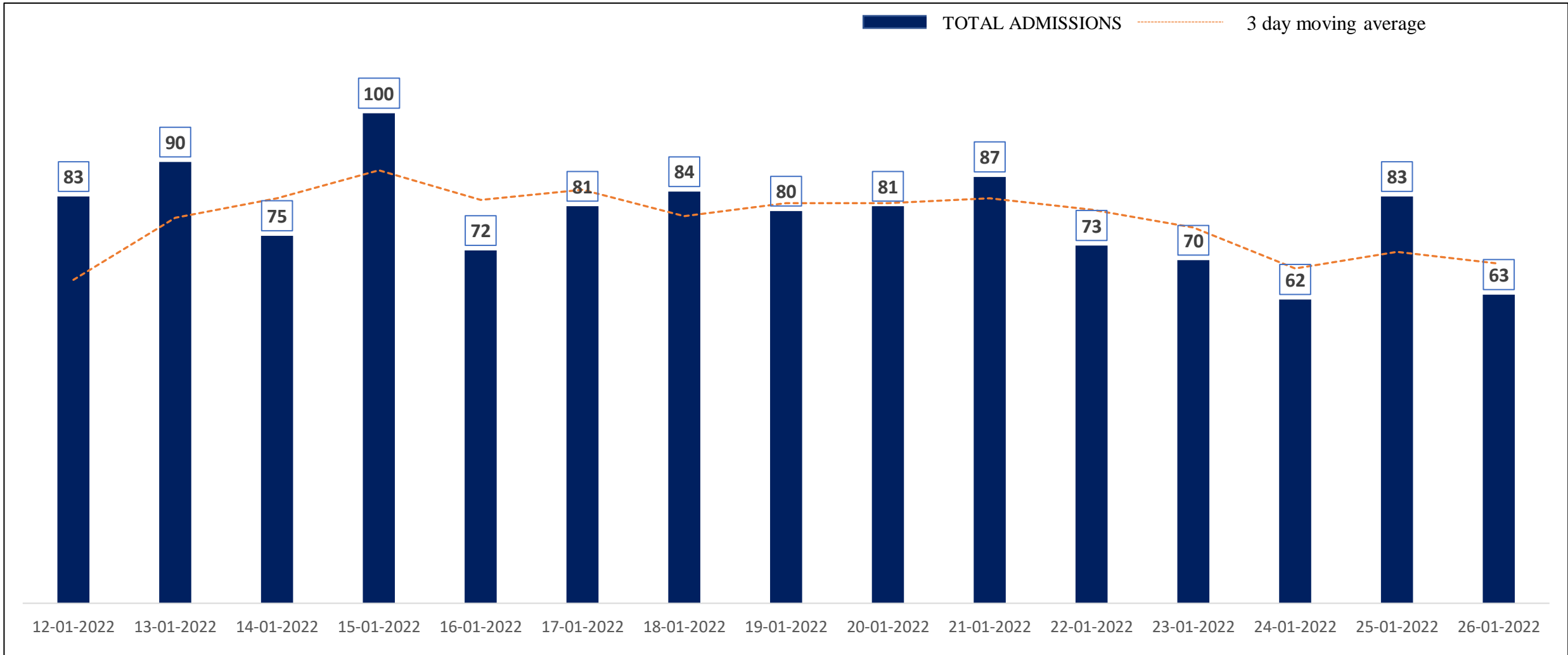

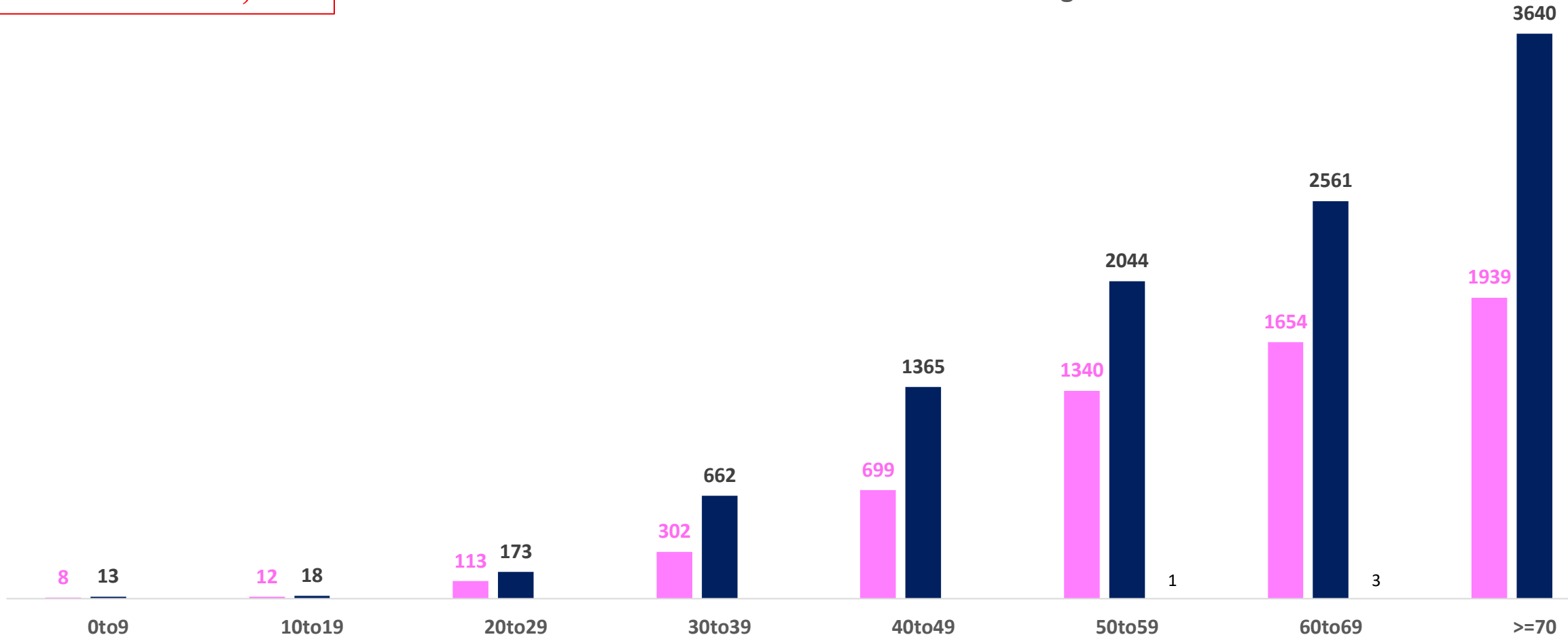


AGE AND GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION OF DEATH CASES



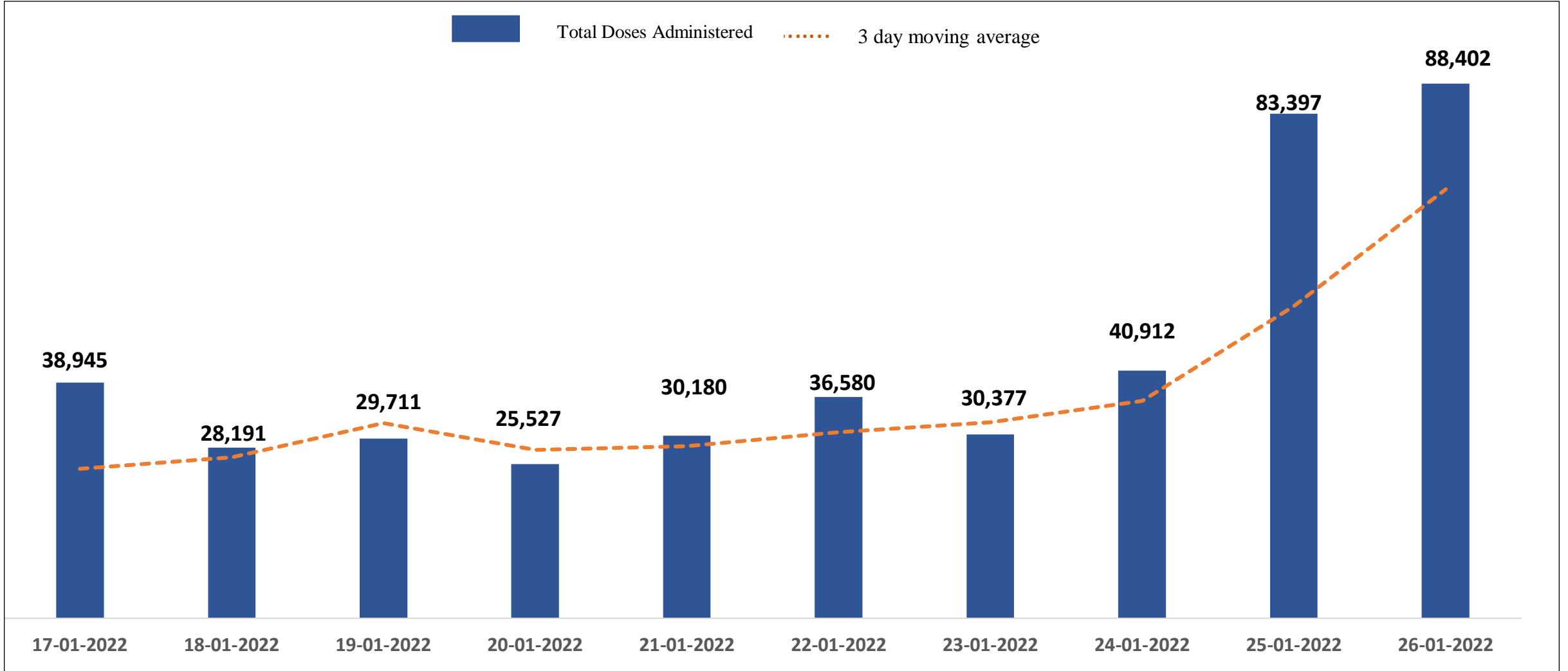

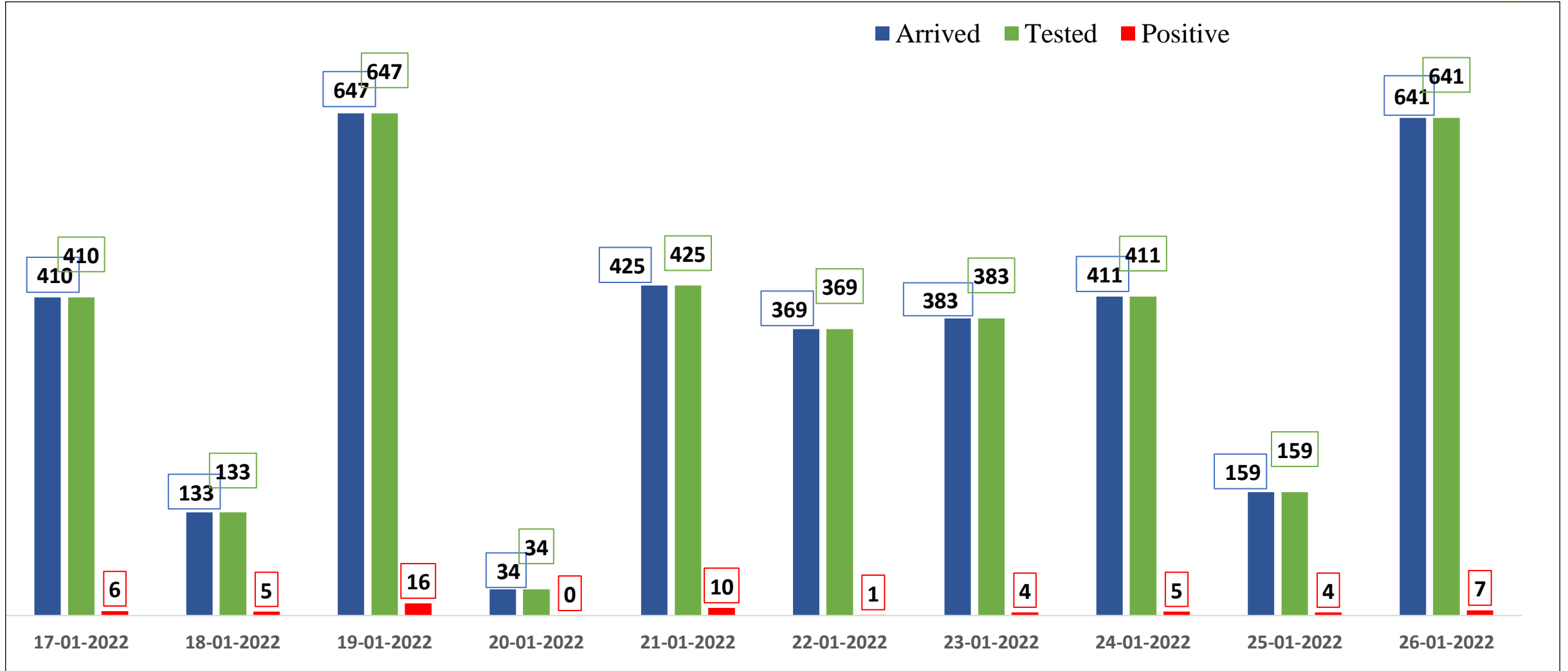


TOTAL VACCINE DOSES ADMINISTERED IN LAST 10 DAYS





INTERNATIONAL TRAVELLERS SURVEILLANCE IN LAST 10 DAYS

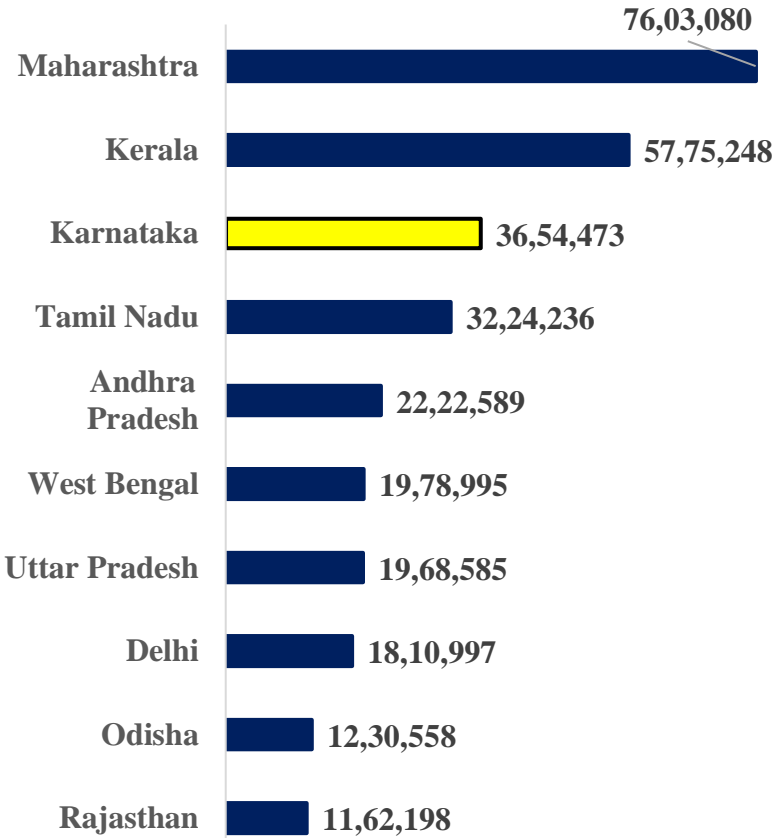




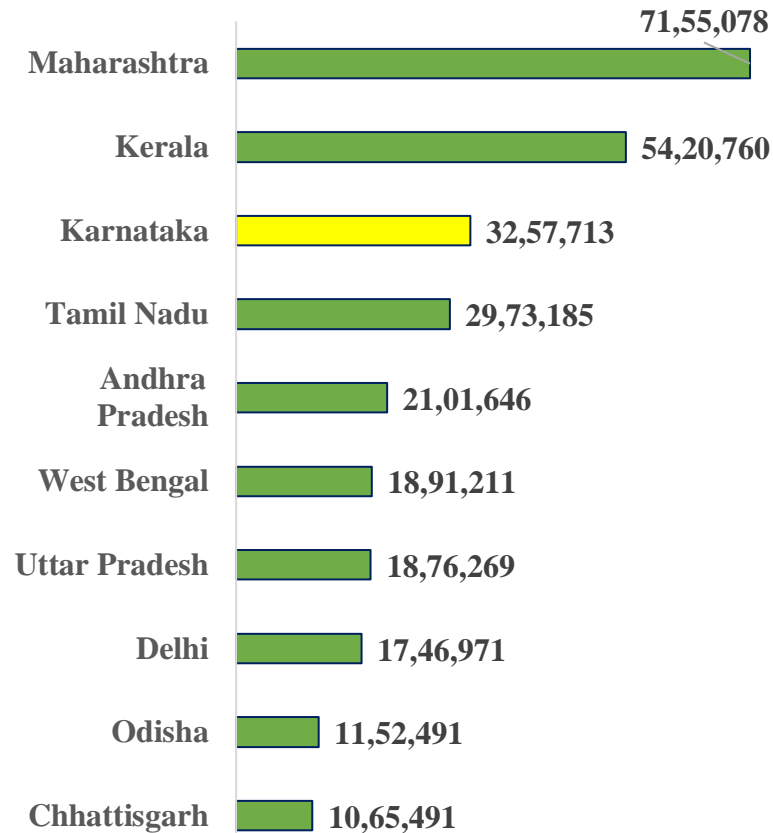

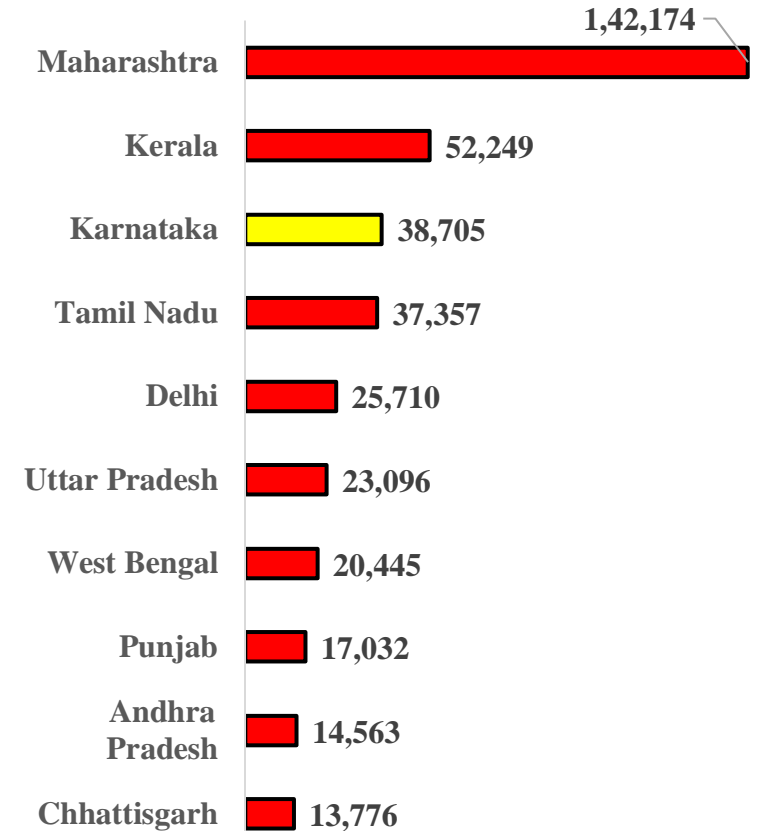

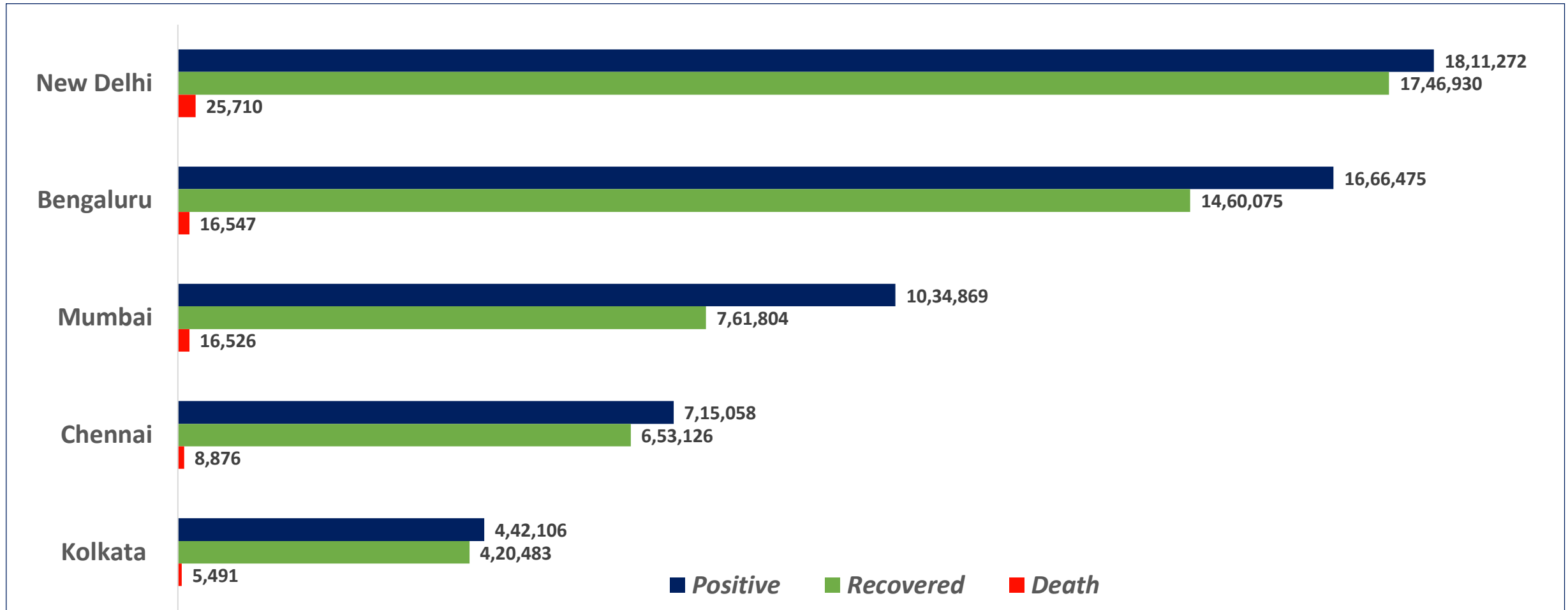

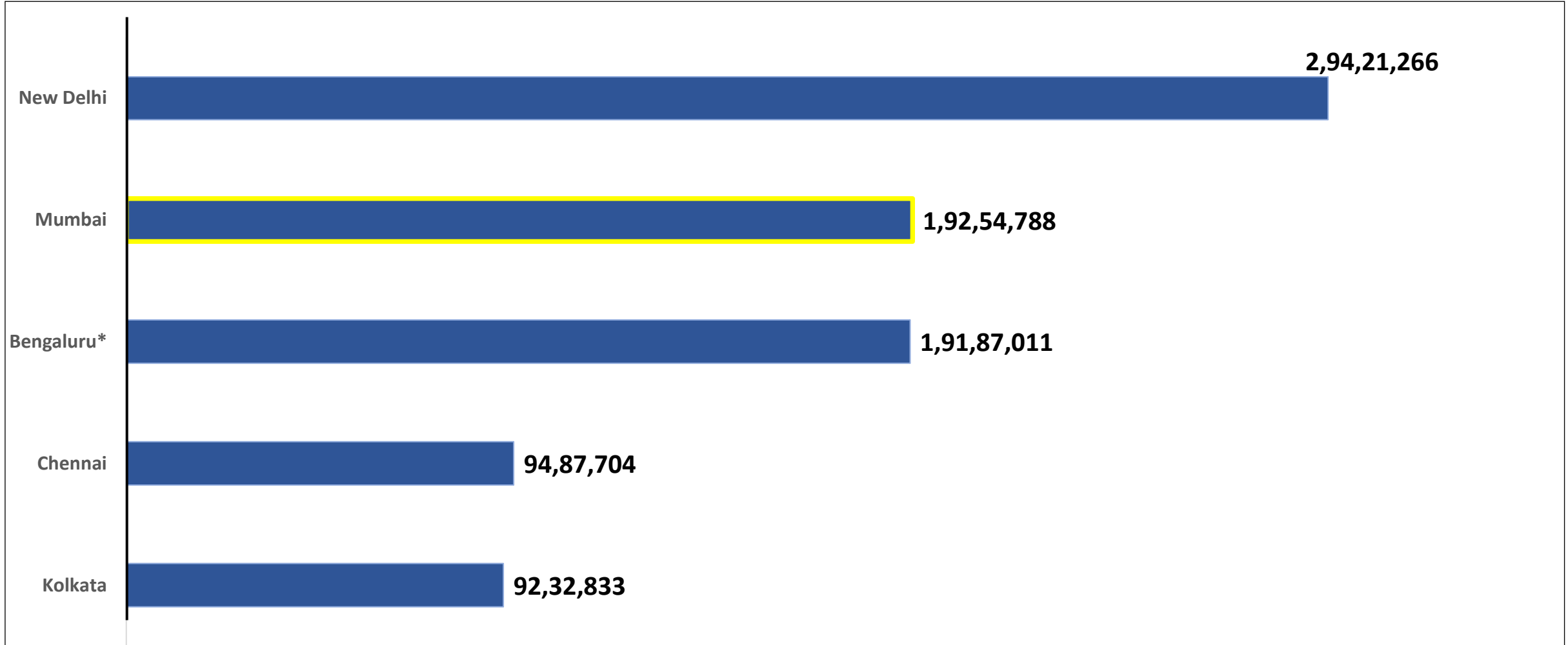

Avoid the Three Cs
Be aware of different levels of risk in different settings

There are certain places where Covid-19 spreads more easily

- Crowded places** with many people nearby
- Close - contact settings** Especially where people have close - range conversations
- Confined and enclosed spaces** with poor ventilation

The risk is higher in places where these factors overlap. Even as restrictions are lifted, consider where you are going and stay safe by avoiding the Three Cs.

Pancha Sutras to prevent Covid-19

- Get 2 doses of Vaccine
- Wash and Sanitize hands frequently
- Avoid mass gatherings
- Wear Face Masks properly covering Nose and Mouth
- When outdoors, follow Covid guidelines properly
