Advisory in view of COVID-19

ACCOMMODATION AND HOSTELS

1. The students from outside Bangalore (including those from outside of Karnataka) residing in Paying Guest (P.G.) accommodations or hostels must be requested to go back home, if their corresponding educational institutions declare holidays.
2. In case an occupant is unable to leave the city under any circumstances, he/she should be made aware of personal hygiene measures as per the advice by the government of Karnataka

3. Cleaning of P.G. accommodation is the sole responsibility of the owner(s)/manager(s).
4. Overcrowding of the rooms is strictly prohibited. A living space (excluding kitchen, toilet/bathroom) of 110 sq. ft. shall not accommodate more than 2 occupants at any point till the outbreak subsides.
5. At no point of time, occupants shall be forcibly thrown out of hostel/PGs without giving prior notification and giving them adequate time to arrange for alternate accommodation.
6. In case of any identified spread of COVID-19 in P.G. accommodations & hostels, strict action shall be taken against the owner(s) and manager(s) viewing it as a gross negligence on their part.
