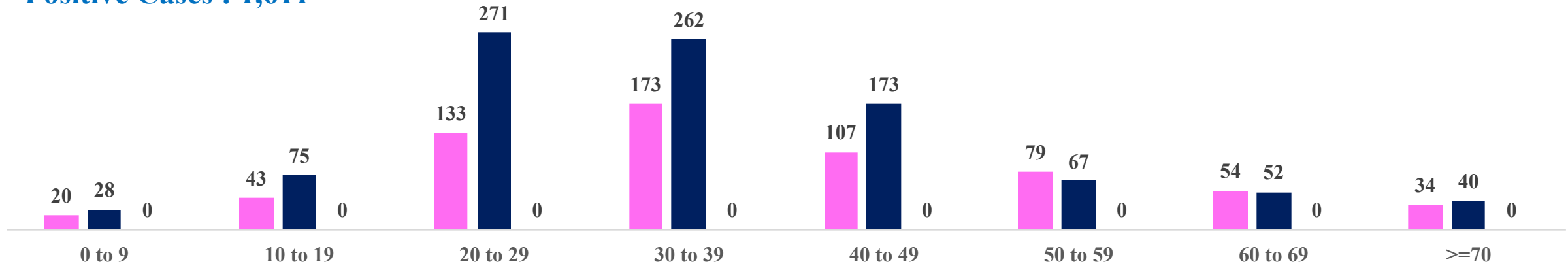


# LAST 24 HOURS AGE GROUP AND GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION

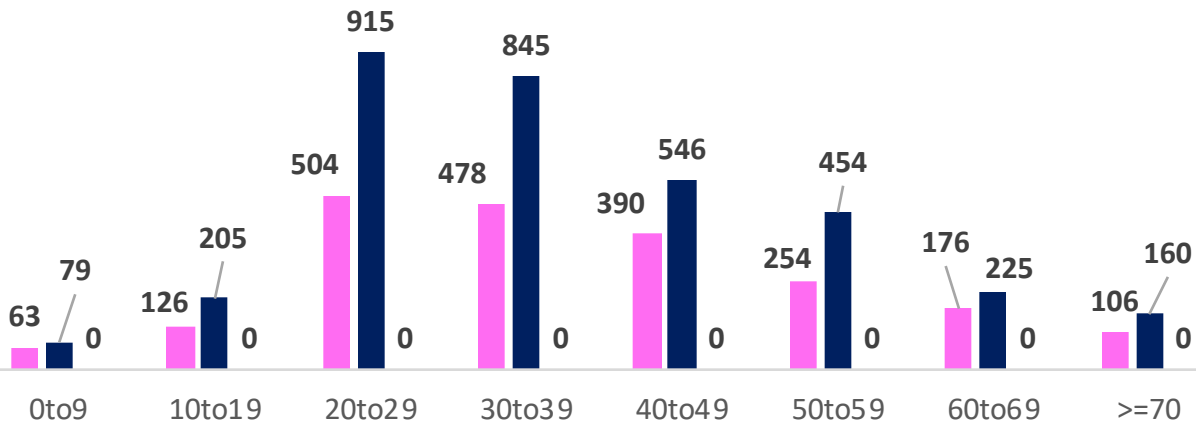

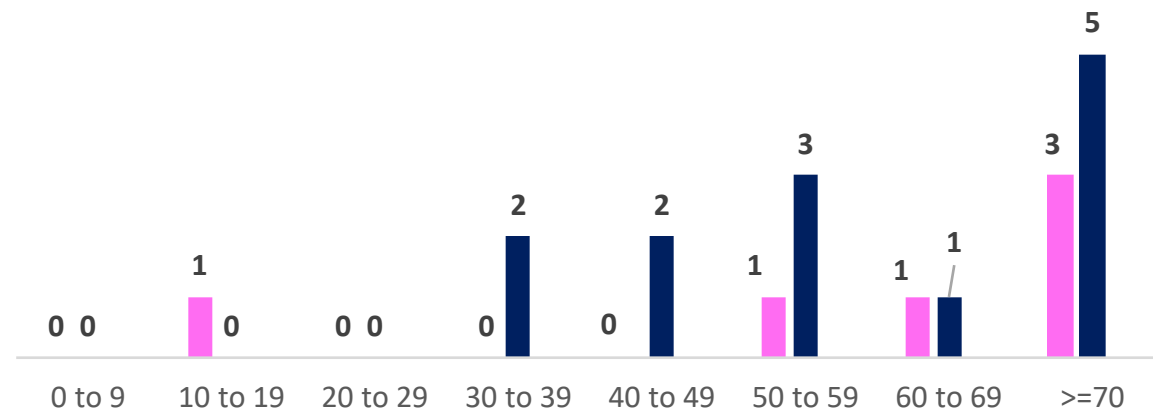

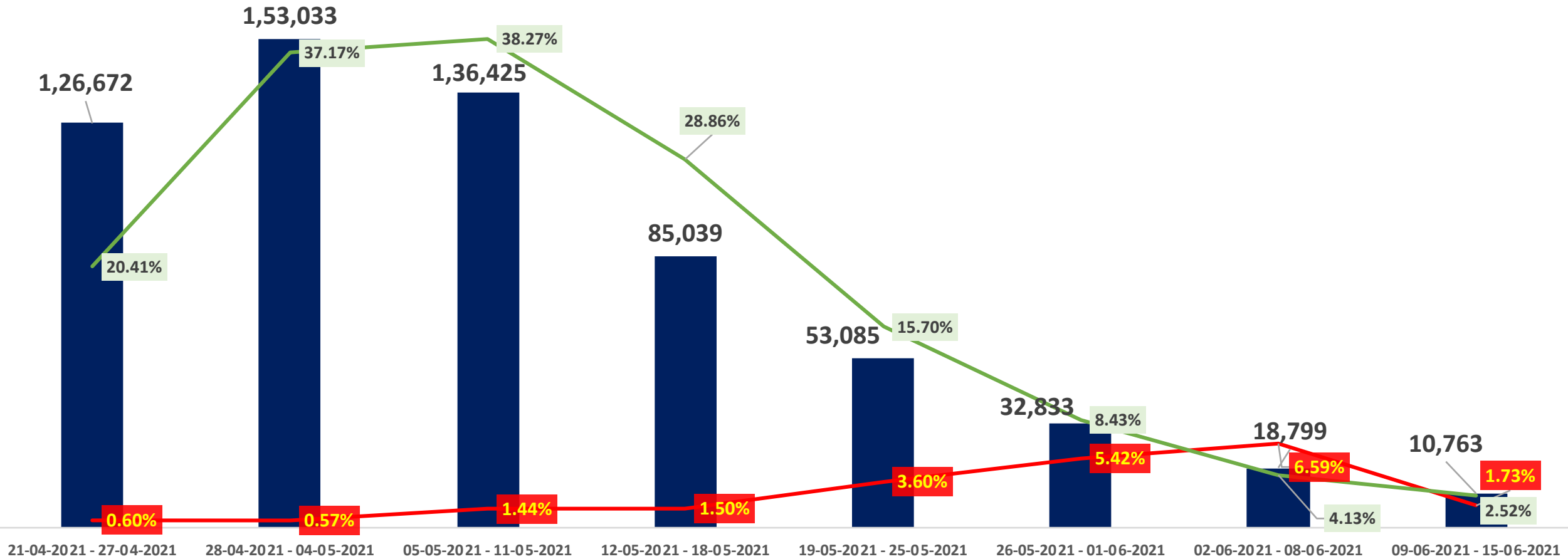

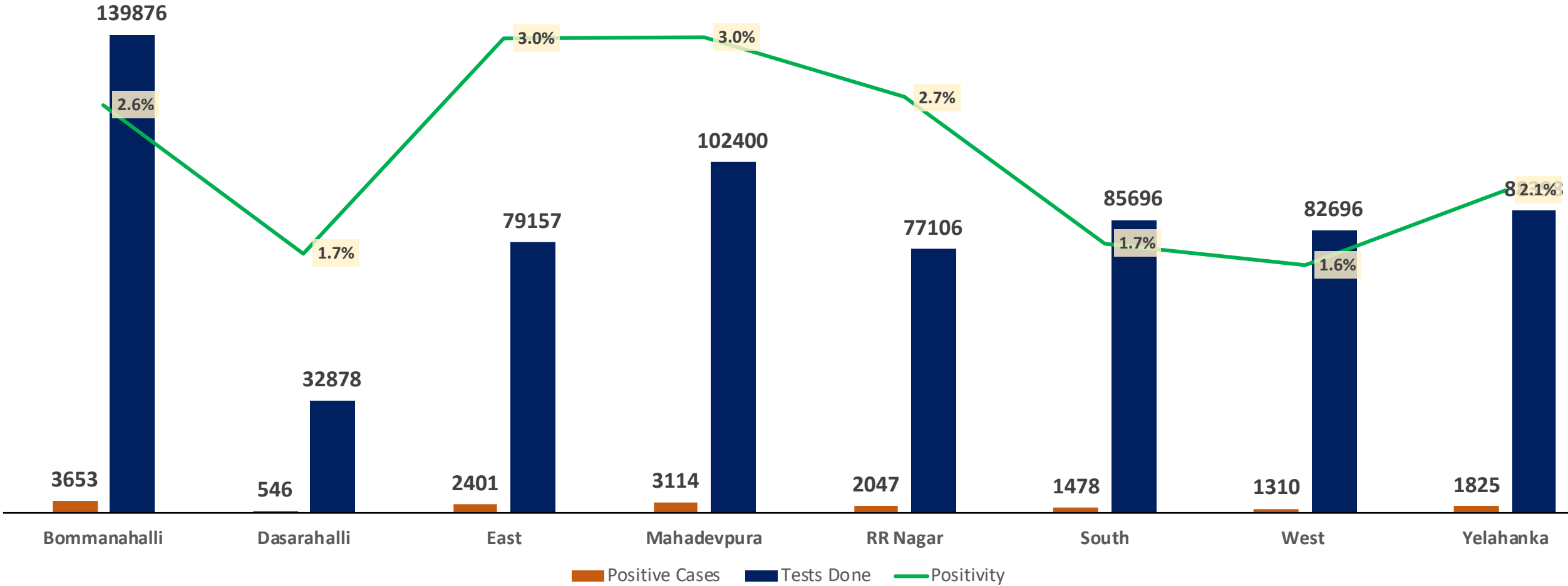

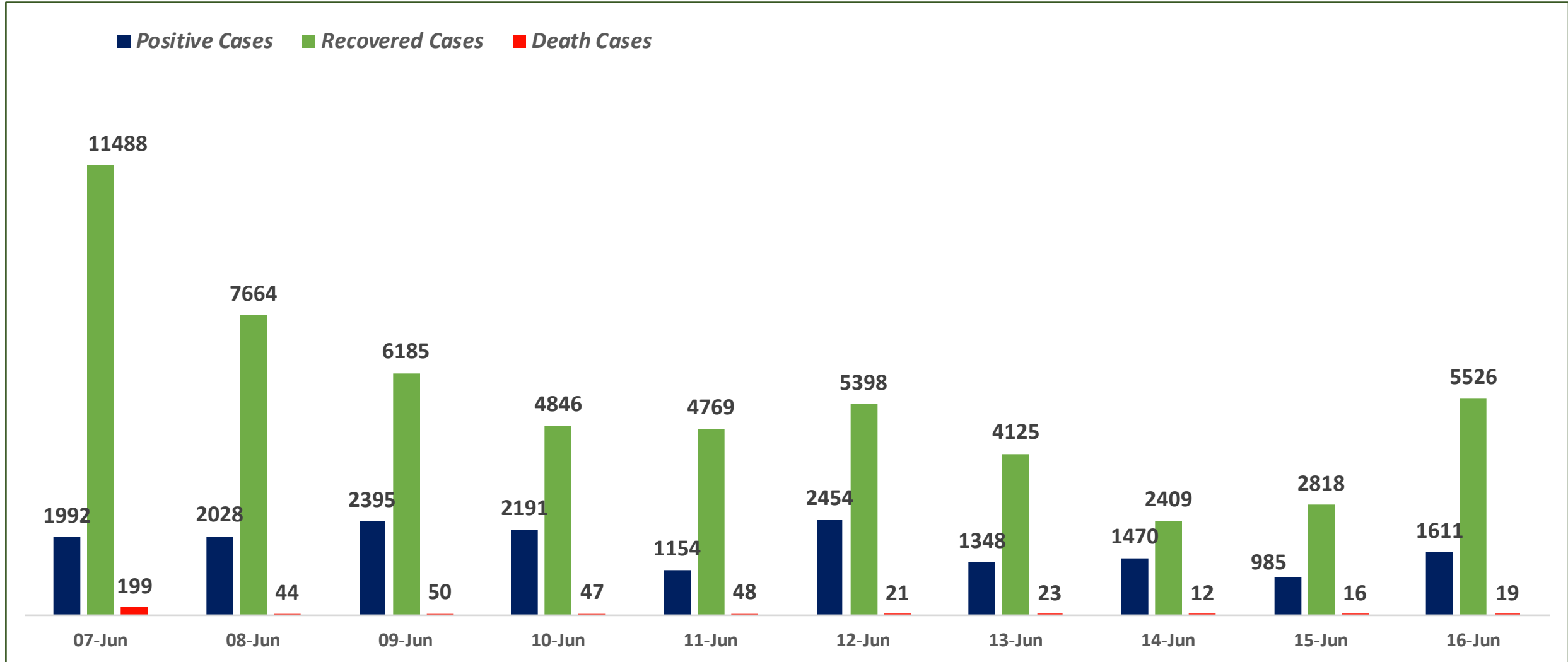


# ZONE WISE POSITIVITY TREND IN LAST 10 DAYS





# SNAPSHOT OF POSITIVE, RECOVERED AND DEATH CASES OVER LAST 10 DAYS ACROSS BBMP ZONES

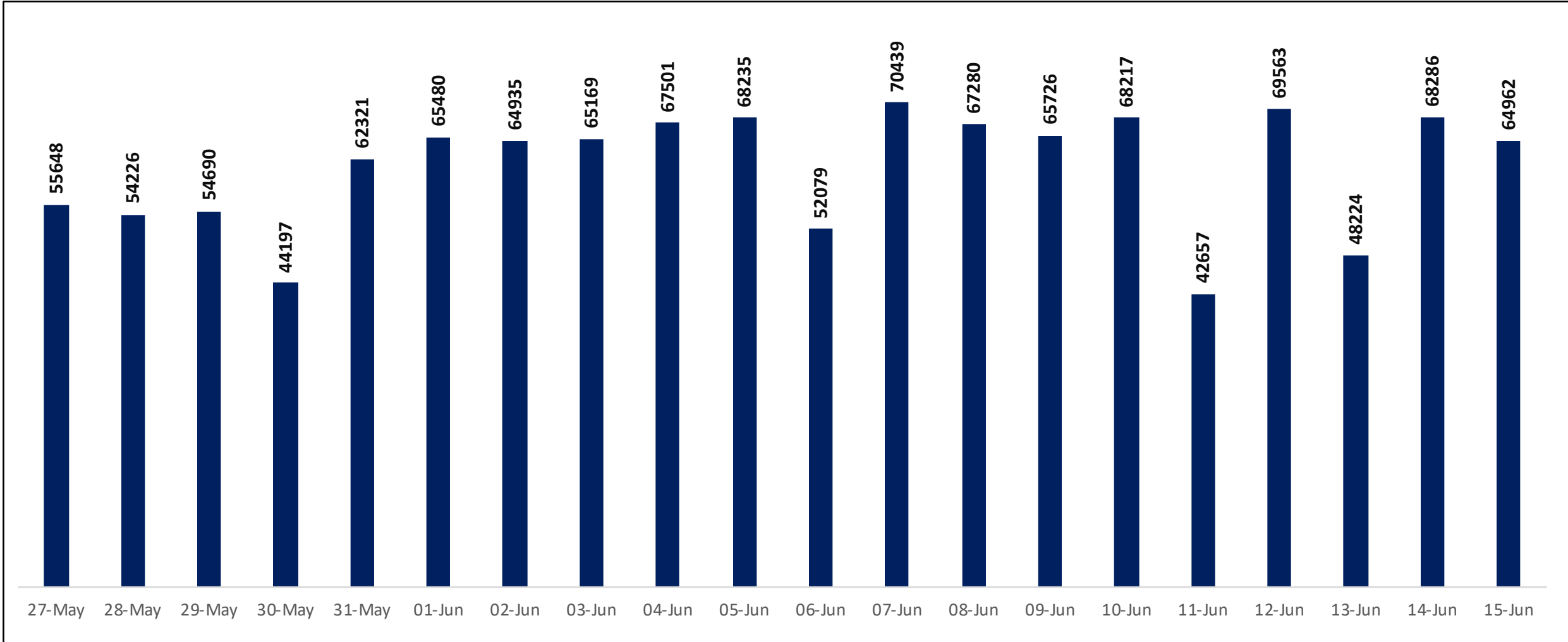

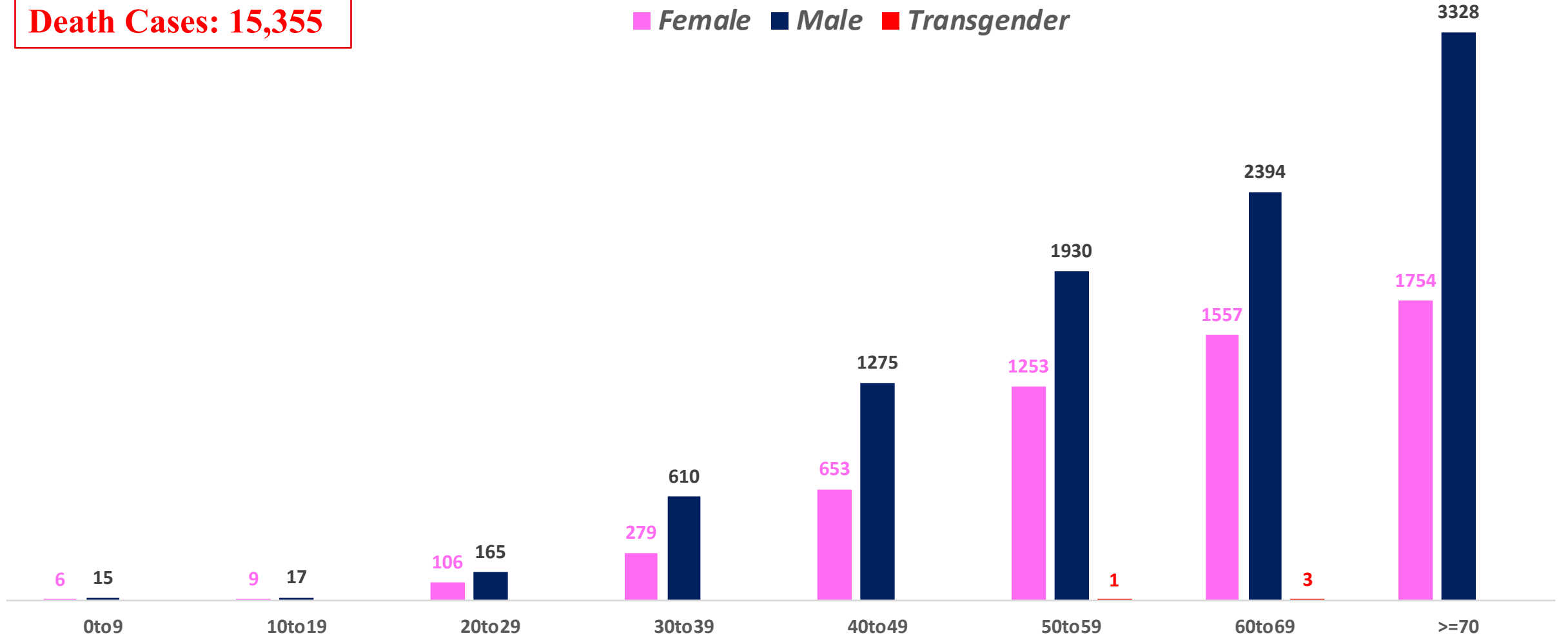


# AGE AND GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION OF DEATH CASES

■ Female ■ Male ■ Transgender

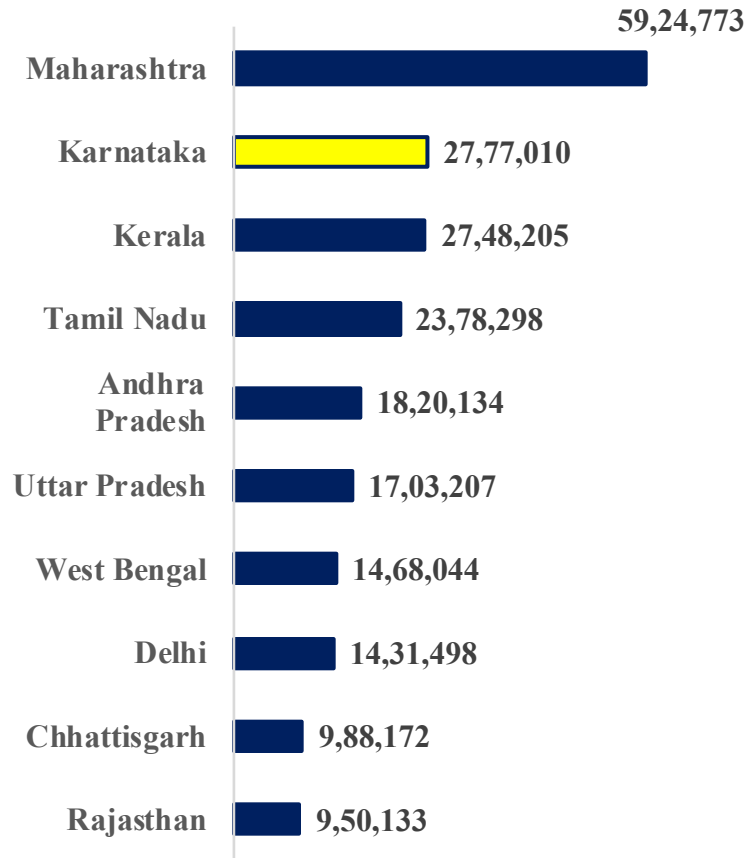




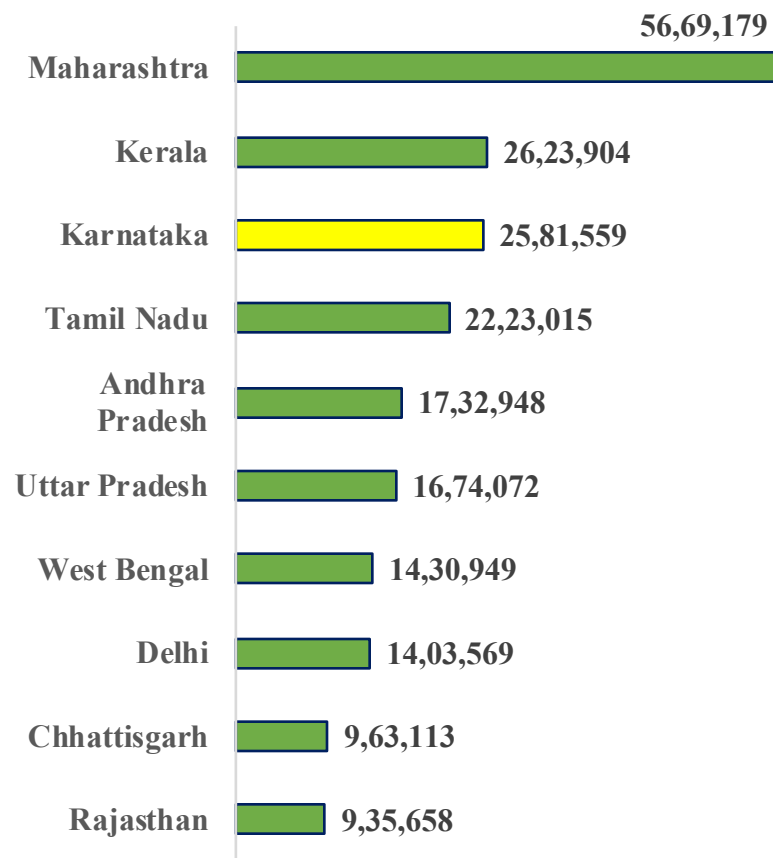

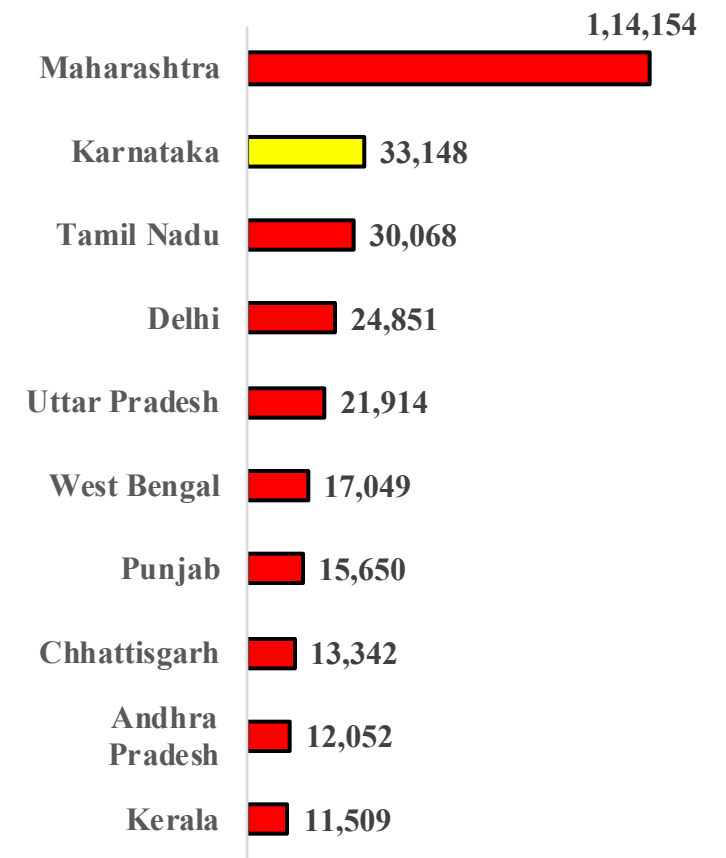

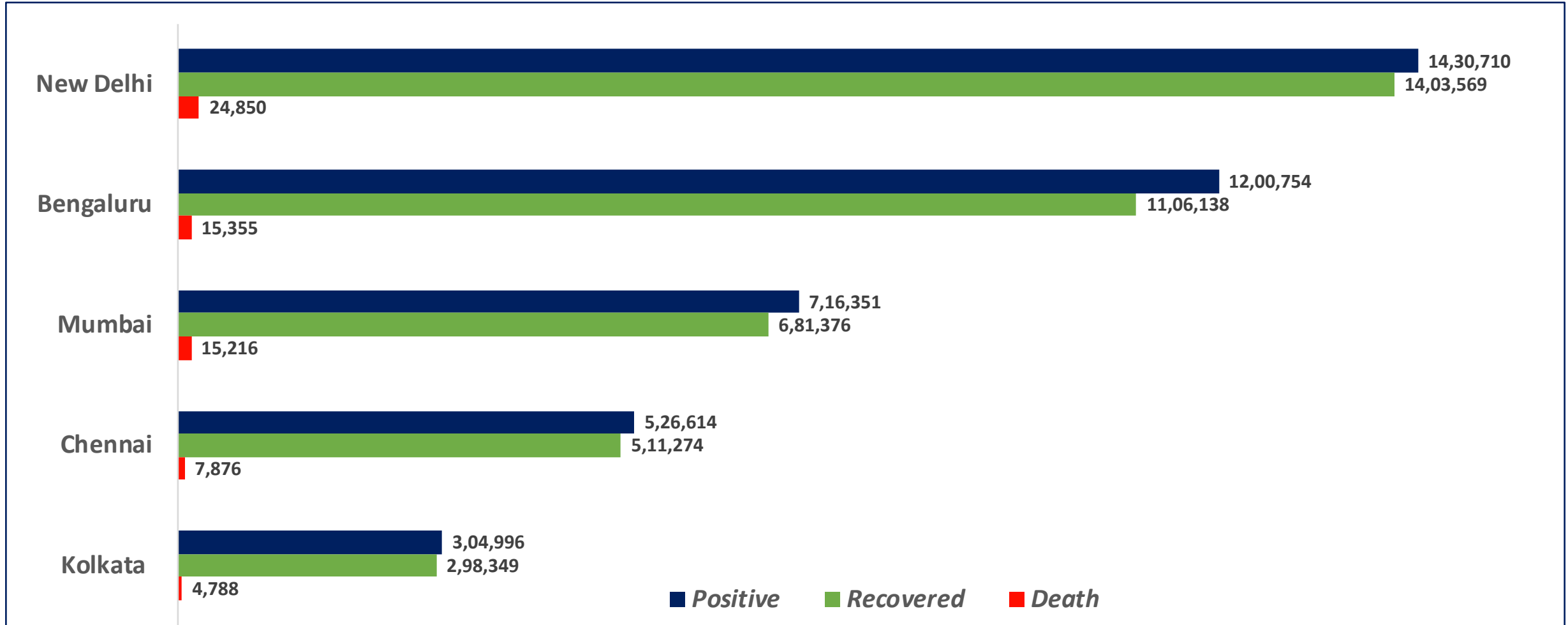

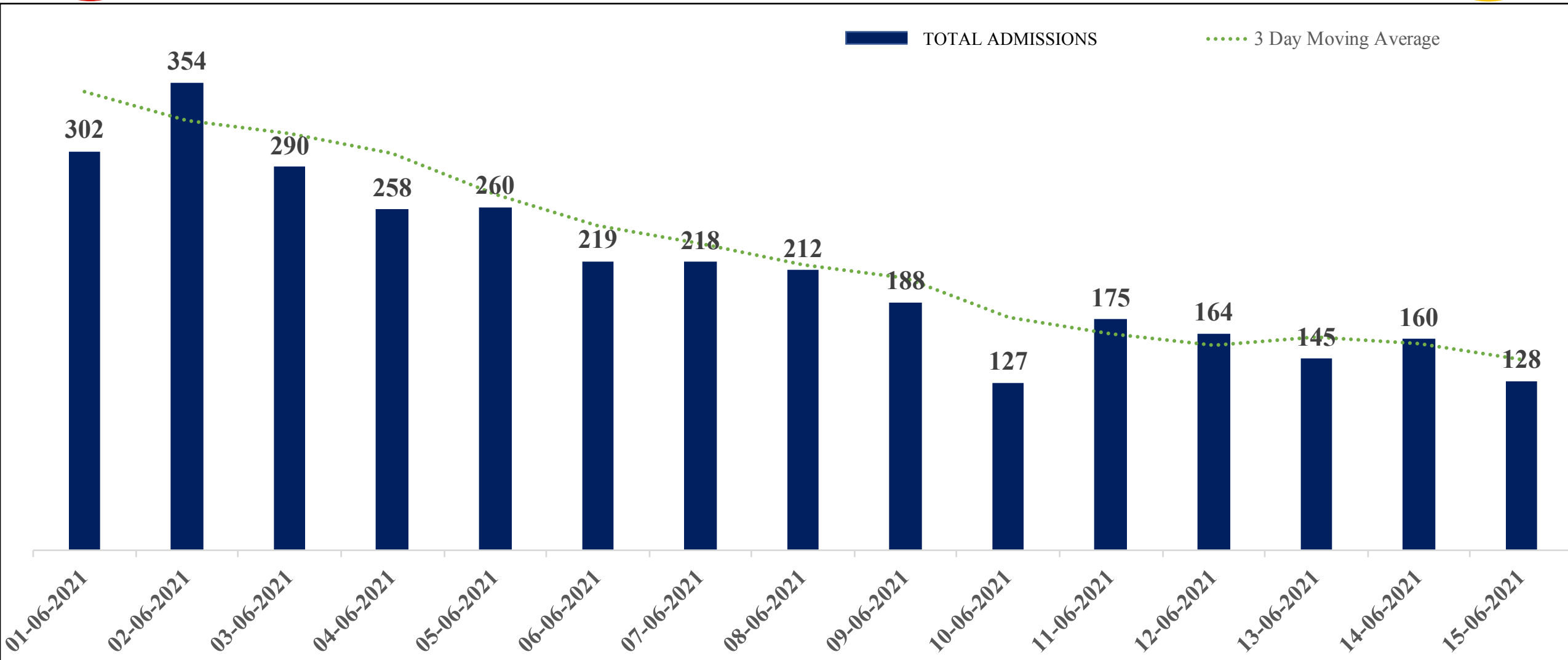

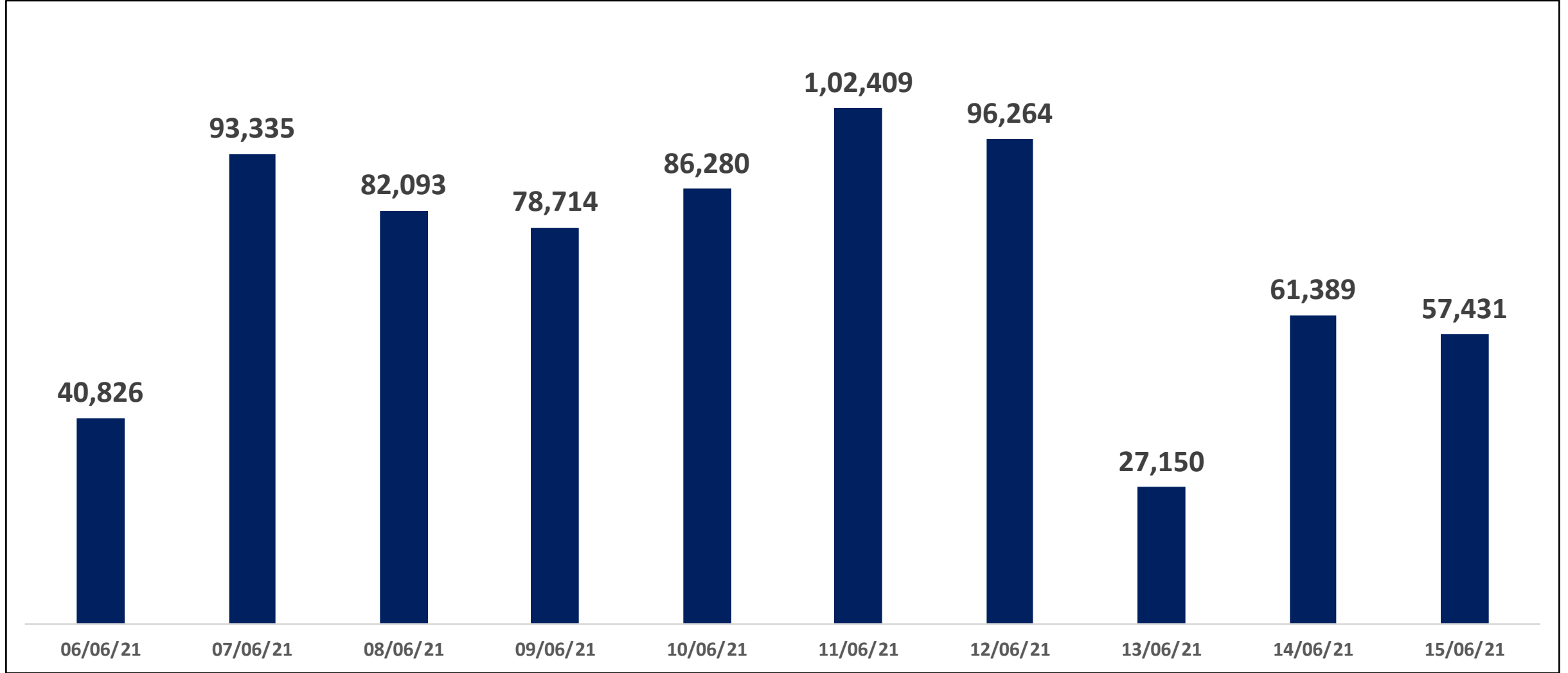

**ROUTES OF VIRUS TRANSMISSION**


- 1. Aerosols**
- 2. Droplets**
- 3. Surface**

1. The **SARS-CoV-2 multiplies in the body** of an infected person, the '**host**', and from there can be transmitted to others **when the host is exhaling, talking, speaking, singing, laughing, coughing, and sneezing** etc.

2. Even one infected person **showing no symptoms** can release enough droplets to **create a "viral load"** that can **infect many others.**

**Wear a mask** even when you are around people who do not show **any symptoms of infection.**
