## 1. Overview of CAC activities:

- A written exam is being planned to be conducted on August 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- The evaluation of written exam and shortlisting for the interviews will be done on September 10, 2024.
- The interview dates will be communicated with the shortlisted candidates on September 11, 2024.
- The interviews will be conducted on September 17, 18 and 19, 2024.
- The final selection of candidates will be done on September 19 or 20, 2024.

# 3. Good Practices and BluGreen Awards

- WRI India has developed a summary template for documenting good practices. Two case studies have been documented as examples.
- A note outlining what constitutes a "Good Practice" will be provided. This note will detail
  the categorization of good practices, which will be used as a basis for conducting / roll-out
  of the BluGreen Awards.
- A detailed form with required fields for capturing details through a call for entry for BluGreen Awards will have to be prepared guided by the Good Practice Template.
- BluGreen Awards will be planned for the upcoming year in 2025, tentatively in the month
  of January. A timeline of preparatory activities will be prepared, including time for onground validation of entries.
